At the December 19, 2023 Council meeting, Charlene Godfrey who represented Bedford District on Council submitted her resignation. In accordance with Section 262 of the Municipal Act, 2001, Council will declare the seat vacant at the January 9, 2024 Council meeting.

Within sixty days after Council has declared the seat vacant, Section 263 of the Act requires Council to fill the vacancy by appointing a person who has consented to accept the office or pass a by-law requiring a by-election be held to fill the vacancy.

#### South Frontenac Township Passes 2.74% Budget Increase for 2024

South Frontenac Township Council passed the 2024 budget at the December 19, 2023 budget meeting. The Total Operating and Capital Budget of \$44,553,398 million represents a 2.74% increase to the average household or \$47.04 a year\*.

The budget addresses ongoing priorities such as road and bridge projects, facilities and fleet upgrades, recreational programming and events, technology improvements, climate change, an economic development strategy and transportation master plan.
