2024 Dog Tags Now on Sale

2024 dog tags are now on sale and are just \$15 until March 1, 2024 when the price goes up to \$30. Garbage Bag Tags

If you are running low on garbage bag tags, you can buy extra tags for \$2 each at several local retailers or our municipal office. See the list of retailers on the Solid Waste section of our website. We'll include a new supply for 2024 in the March tax mailing. Please remember to tag your bags and have them to the curb by 7 am. The maximum weight for bags and blue boxes is 20 kgs/44 lbs.

We will replace or repair mailboxes and mountings if we determine the damage was caused by Township snowplows (sometimes it's not the plow, but the weight of the snow that causes the damage). Green Light for Additional Dwelling Units in South Frontenac

On January 23, 2024, new bylaws came into effect for additional dwelling units in South Frontenac. An additional dwelling unit is a self-contained residential unit with its own kitchen, bathroom facilities and sleeping area on a property that already has a house on it. For a rural municipality like South Frontenac, they are a creative solution to provide more housing options.

In South Frontenac, you can build up to two additional dwelling units on one property, one or two in the primary dwelling and one in an accessory building for a total of three residential units on one lot. The proposal must meet zoning and building code requirements. We've posted many helpful materials on our website for residents who are thinking about building an additional dwelling unit on their property. See southfrontenac.net/ADUs for more details.
