Sydenham Lake Bridge and Dam Work

Work has begun to rehabilitate the bridge and dam on George Street in Sydenham just south of Home Hardware. Geese Control Measures

We are getting a jump on geese control this year to keep our parks and beaches clean, safe and open. We'll be using herding dogs once again and new this year, birds of prey to redirect geese in Point Park in Sydenham. The use of herding dogs and birds of prey are an effective, humane way to redirect geese from public parks to more naturalized areas. Please help us in these efforts and don't feed the geese, seagulls or any wildlife. While you're free to watch the dogs and birds of prey in action, please don't interrupt them while they're working.
